The price of sugary drinks has risen due to tax

Lovers of soft drinks will have to fork out just a little bit extra for their fizzy beverages as the UK's sugar tax comes into effect.

The tax will depend on how much sugar is included in the product. The tax sees companies having to pay 18p per litre for drinks which contain more than 5g of sugar per 100ml or 24p per litre for those containing over 8g per 100ml.

What's being billed as the world's first luxury space hotel, Aurora Station, was announced Thursday at the Space 2.0 Summit in San Jose, California.

Developed by US-based space technology start-up Orion Span, the fully modular space station will host six people at a time, including two crew members, for 12-day

trips of space travel. It plans to welcome its first quests in 2022.
