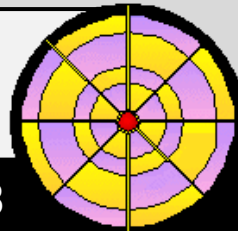

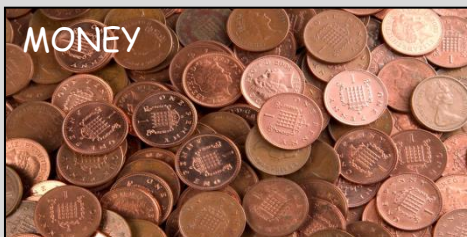

Future of 1p and 2p coins rescued amid backlash

The Government has signalled 1p and 2p coins won't be scrapped - a day after the Treasury announced a consultation on their use. The Treasury document noted how 60% of 1p and 2p coins are only used in a transaction once before leaving circulation, with coppers then either saved or, in 8% of cases, thrown away.

Stephen Hawking: Visionary physicist dies

World renowned physicist Stephen Hawking has died at the age of 76.

The British scientist was famed for his work with black holes and relativity, and wrote several popular science books including *A Brief History of Time*.
