
Nissan Leaf electric car goes further with one-pedal driving

Nissan has launched a longer-range version of its best-selling Leaf electric vehicle, as it fights growing competition in the electric car market.

But it still falls short of the ranges offered by other electric cars as we can see from the bar graph opposite.

The electric car with the furthest range is the Tesla Model X. It can run, in tolerance notation, for (265 ± 45) miles before needing re-charged.
