
Snapchat owner worth up to \$25bn despite making losses

Snap, owner of the Snapchat messaging app popular with teenagers, is to sell its shares on the US stock market.

The business is expected to be valued at between \$20bn and \$25bn, although Snap has never made a profit. It will turn the company's founders into multi-billionaires.

Snap now has nearly 160 million daily users. This is considerably less than it's social media rival Facebook who draw in $1\cdot2$ billion daily users.
