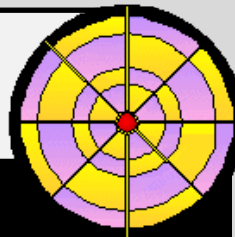


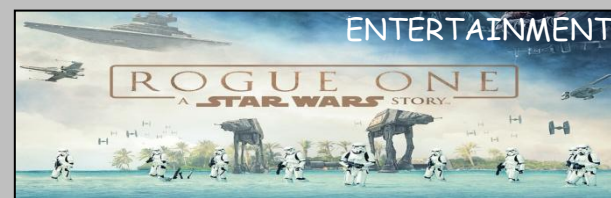

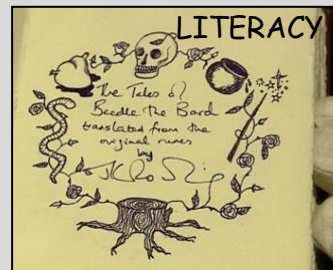
## Rare Harry Potter book fetches a lot at auction!
