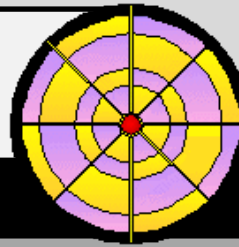

## Amma canteen: Where an Indian meal costs only seven cents

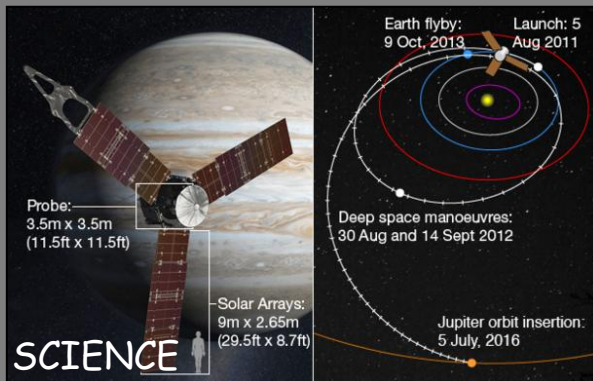
