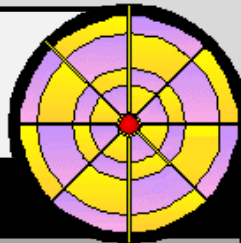

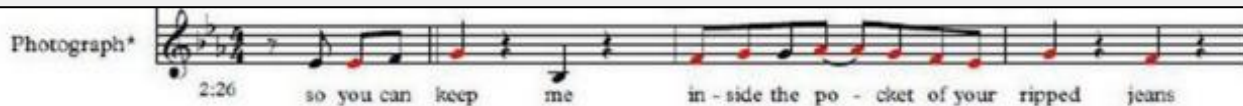

Ed Sheeran is being sued for \$20m by two songwriters over his track Photograph

Two US musicians are suing Ed Sheeran for \$20 million (£13.8 million) over his single Photograph. Martin Harrington and American Thomas Leonard claim it has a similar structure to their song, Amazing, written in 2009.
