

Dutchman ends 'world's longest electric car trip' in Australia

A Dutchman completed an epic 59 000 mile journey by electric car in Sydney Sunday in a bid to prove the viability of such vehicles in tackling climate change.

Wiebe Wakker drove his retrofitted station wagon nicknamed "The Blue Bandit" across 33 countries in what he said was the world's longest ever journey by electric car.

The trip from the Netherlands

to Australia took just over three years and was funded by public donations from around the world, including electricity to charge the Bandit, food and a place to sleep.

Wiebe claims his car can travel 124 miles on a full charge. How many times would he have needed to fully charge his car in order to complete his journey?
