Sir Mo will have to run the race of his life if he's to beat the reigning champion and world record holder, Eliud Kipchoge of Kenya, who has won the marathon three times.



Kipchoge is the favourite to win after smashing the world record in Berlin in September with a time of 2:01:39.

The time Eliud set in Berlin is 86 seconds FASTER than the record for the London Marathon - another record set by Eliud in 2016.

Rise of Skywalker trailer racks up more views than the Force Awakens & the Last Jedi

Star Wars: The Rise of Skywalker is still months away but it's already managed to lock up one record. During its first 24 hours of release, the trailer for the final chapter of the Skywalker saga logged 111 million trailer views.

That's more than double what The Force Awakens teaser trailer



pulled in and 20 million more than the first trailer for The Last Jedi.
