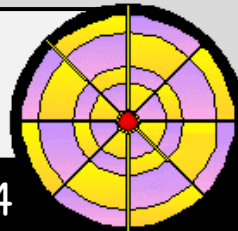

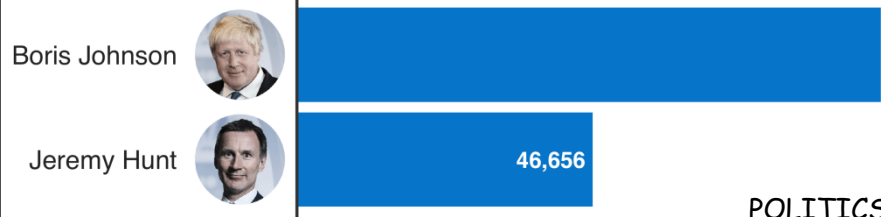

## Boris Johnson wins race to be Tory leader and PM

## Adam Peaty breaks 100m breaststroke world record

Adam Peaty has broken his own world record in the men's 100 metres breaststroke at the World Championships in Gwangju, South Korea.

In doing so, the Briton achieved one of his career goals of becoming the first man to break the 57-second barrier in the event.

He has now swum the event 1.4 seconds faster than anyone else in history and has set the best 16 times ever recorded in the 100 metre breaststroke.

Peaty, 24, smashed the previous record of 57.1 seconds he set at last year's European Championships to win his semi-final in 56.88 on Sunday.
