Katarina Johnson-Thompson wins World Athletics Championships heptathlon gold

Katarina Johnson-Thompson ended her wait for her first global outdoor title by powering to heptathlon gold at the World Championships in Doha.




The 26 year old, previously without an outdoor medal at this level, won with a British record 6981 points, beating 2017 champion Nafissatou Thiam by 304 points.

Researchers at the University of Cambridge and Aalto University in Finland found that smartphone design and typing features are rapidly improving mobile typing speeds.

Norfolk and Suffolk greenhouse plan 'will provide 10% of UK tomatoes'

Two giant greenhouses costing £120m are to be built next to sewage works to grow millions of tomatoes and bring 360 agricultural jobs.



Work on the greenhouses, the UK's largest, has already begun at Trowse, near Norwich, and Ingham, Suffolk. When complete, they aim to provide 10% of the UK's tomatoes.
