
Outcome 1 - Probability Timelines


Bronze example

 - (c) The next child you see will be a boy.




- (a) Selecting the letter S from the word CLASSROOMS.

 - (c) Picking a black pen from a box with 4 red and 6 black.




- (a) Selecting the letter A from the word ATTENDANCE.
