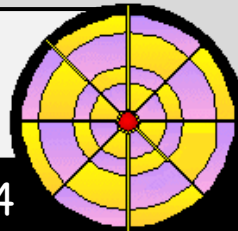

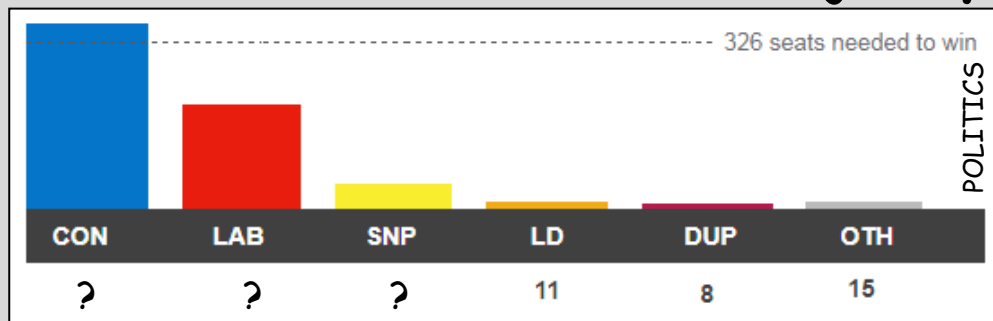

UK results: Conservatives win majority

The 2019 UK general election was held last Thursday.

A general election is an opportunity for people in every part of the UK to choose their MP. This person will represent a local area (constituency) in the House of Commons for up to five years. Altogether, there are 650 MP's (seats) in the UK.

The UK uses a "first past the post" system to determine a winner. The first party who has 326 MP's elected is declared the out right winner.



- Can you explain why the first party to have 326 MP's elected is declared the winner?
- The Conservative party won 47 MORE seats than the 318 they won in the 2017 general election. How many seats did they win in this general election?
- The Labour party won 59 FEWER seats than the 262 they won in the 2017 general election. How many seats did Labour win in this general election?
- How many seats did the SNP win in this general election?

Cyclist takes nine hours to create reindeer picture on Strava map
