Rolling a dice and getting a number less than 7.  Certain

















If today is Monday then tomorrow will be Sunday.  Impossible

Using the vocabulary of probability, describe the outcome of the following events...

-  The next baby you see will be a girl. 
-  A word will contain the letter 'x'. 
-  No trains will be on time tomorrow. 
-  Picking a month of the year at random and choosing June. 
-  A football team will lose at least one match during a season. 
-  Rolling a dice and getting a number less than 4. 
-  It will snow in Scotland at some point next winter. 
-  From the days of the year, choosing Halloween at random.

-  A tennis player will win the next Wimbledon. 
-  If today is Wednesday then tomorrow will be Friday. 
-  The Christmas holidays will be in July next year. 
-  An ice-cream will melt if left on a hot, summer's day. 
-  Peru will win the next football European Championships. 
-  A rugby team will win the next 6 nations tournament. 
-  The sun will rise tomorrow morning. 
-  The total score of two dice is more than 12.
