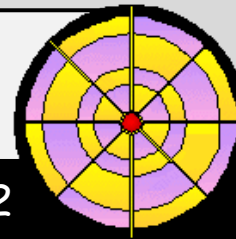

Biden inauguration: New president sworn in



Joe Biden was sworn in on Wednesday as the 46th US president, ending one of the most dramatic political transitions in American history.

Donald Trump (who has still not formally conceded the presidency to Mr Biden) snubbed the inauguration ceremony.

Biden won the election with record number of votes in a Presidential Election ever.

Trump, at 74 million, actually received the 2nd highest number of votes ever despite finishing as runner up - 7 million fewer votes than Biden.

Biden was also the oldest president to take the oath aged 78 years and 61 days.
