Scrapped GoldenEye 007 game 'remaster' leaks online

A highly sought-after remaster of the hit James Bond video game Golden Eye 007 has been leaked online more than a decade after it was cancelled.

Developer Rare produced the original game in 1997 for gaming giant Nintendo, and was working on an updated version for the Xbox in 2007.

But the project was scrapped because the various parties involved could not reach an agreement over rights.

GoldenEye 007 is the 3rd highest selling game for the Nintendo 64.


'Smallest reptile on earth' discovered in Madagascar
