Ford Mondeo is being discontinued after nearly 20 years in production

Ford has announced that it will no longer be selling the iconic Mondeo, with the car to be 'phased out' by next March.

The saloon car is instantly recognisable to most people in the UK, and millions have been sold around the world since it was introduced in 1993.

The current UK number plate system has been in place since September 2001. UK number plates consist of;

- 1. Two letters to show where the car was registered
- 2. Two numbers as an age identifier
- 3. 3 random letters to uniquely identify the car.

The old 'prefix' number plate system began in August 1983 as a once-annual plate change. The first letter shown was the age identifier and represented the year the car was registered i.e. 'A' = 1983, 'B' = 1984, 'C' = 1985, etc. The letters 'I', 'O', 'Q', 'U' and 'Z' were not used in this system. In 1999, this was updated with a new letter every six months and then continued until the system above was put into place in September 2001.

- (c) Amaro's big sister Mia is three years older than him. What is Mia's date of birth?


Tipping Point host lacks Growth Mindset
