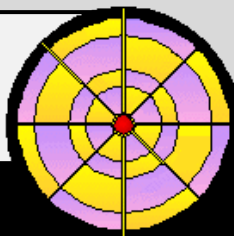

Steps are a British dance-pop group who first hit the UK charts with the song "5, 6, 7, 8" in 1998.

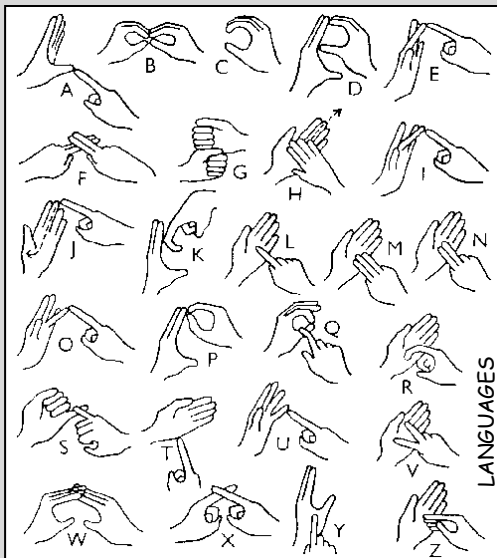
