


Limited edition £5 coin honouring Prince Philip unveiled

New Hungry Hippos Guinness World Record

Donald McNeill from the USA this week recorded the fastest time to clear a game of Hungry Hippos.



He completed the game in just 14.69 seconds!

In the game Hungry Hungry Hippos, a maximum of 4 players hover over a proving ground full of 20 plastic balls. The player who "eats" the most wins.

In a 4 player game, player 1 "eats" x balls. Player 2 "eats" twice as many as player 1. Player 3 "eats" twice as many as player 2. Player 4 "eats" 3 times as many as player 1.

Lego plans to sell bricks from recycled bottles in two years

Toy giant Lego is aiming to put bricks made from recycled drinks bottles on shelves within two years.



Lego currently makes between 110 and 120 billion plastic pieces per year and the firm emits about 1.2 million tonnes of carbon per year.
