#### Swiss researchers calculate pi to new record number of decimal places

Swiss researchers have calculated the mathematical constant pi to a new world-record of decimal places. They managed to record 62 800 000 000 000 figures using a supercomputer.

(a) Write this figure in words.

The calculation took 108 days and nine hours.

(b) How many minutes did the calculation take?

Pi,  $\pi$ , is a mathematical constant that can be calculated by dividing the circumference of any circle by its diameter. It has an infinite number of decimal places. Chao Lou from China holds the record for memorising the most digits of  $\pi$  - 67 890 to be precise!

(c) How many digits can you memorise  $\pi$  to? Ask someone in your class to test you!

## John Higgins scores 12th career 147

John Higgins says it is "a proud moment" to have surpassed compatriot Stephen Hendry's career total with a 12th maximum break at the Snooker British Open.

The 46 year old Scot's latest 147 came in the opening frame of his 3-1 first-round win over Alexander Ursenbacher of Switzerland and he is now second, three off Ronnie O'Sullivan, in the all-time list.

A 147 break is the maximum score that a player can get in a visit to the table.

In snooker, a red ball must be potted followed by another colour.

The other colour is then re-spotted and this must be continued until all the red balls have been potted. Once the reds are gone, a player must pot the colours in order; yellow, green, brown, blue, pink and black.
