Asda announces launch of first refill store in Scotland

Asda has launched its first refill store in Scotland in a bid to help customers shop more sustainably.

From last Monday, shoppers at Asda's Toryglen store in Glasgow have been able to use their own



containers to buy unpackaged products such as pasta, rice, tea, coffee and cereals. Customers are also allowed to purchase a reusable

container in store.

Tennis star's favourite subject is Maths

Tennis star Emma Raducanu confirmed in an interview this week that maths was her favourite subject at school. The US Open champion achieved an A* in A Level Maths just before becoming the British number one in tennis.

Bristol half marathon winner disqualified after running wrong race!

The winner of a half marathon has been disqualified because he was only meant to run the distance of a 10 kilometres!



The Bristol half marathon took place alongside the Bristol 10k in the Great Bristol Run last Sunday. Omar Ahmed had originally signed up to run the 10k but took at wrong turn and ended up accidentally running (and winning!) the half marathon in just 63 minutes.

There are approximately 1.61 kilometres in every mile

1.61 Kilometres in every mile and 26.2 miles in a full marathon.

(a) How many extra kilometres did poor Omar have to run after taking his wrong turn?

(b) What was Omar's average speed when running the half marathon? Give your answer in kilometres per hour and round your answer to 1 decimal place.
