Billingham bird box camera targets speeding drivers

He says the 8ft structure, which is painted yellow and silver, has slowed traffic.

Derby County docked nine more points for accounting rule breaches

Back in issue number 262 of the Daily Rigour, we reported that Derby County Football Club were deducted



12 points by the English Football League.

Before the points deduction they had a total of 10 league points.

They have now been deducted a further 9 points after admitting breaches of English Football League accounting rules.
