# Morrisons scraps 'use by' date on milk in favour of sniff test!

Supermarket Morrisons is to scrap 'use by' dates on most of its milk in a move it says will stop millions of pints being poured down the sink.



The retailer will instead place

'best before' on 90% of its own brand milk and encourage customers to use a sniff test to check the quality!

While there are no set recommendations, most research suggests that as long as it's been stored properly, unopened milk generally stays good for 5-7 days past its 'best before' date, while opened milk lasts at least 2-3 days past this date.
