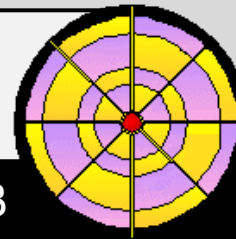


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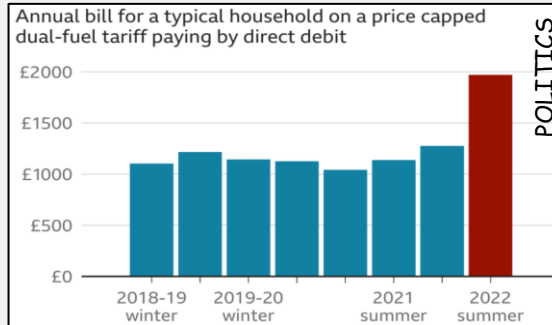

6	Late for start of Training	£20 000

9	Not travelling back on team coach post match without giving 48 hours notice to the Manager or an Assistant manager	£5000

Scotland score late penalty try helps to retain Calcutta Cup
