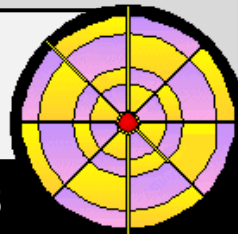

Petrol price hits new record above £1.60 a litre

Petrol prices have risen above £1.60 a litre on average for the first time as Russia's invasion of Ukraine continues to affect the cost of oil worldwide.

Unleaded petrol hit £1.61 a litre on Thursday while diesel reached £1.70 a litre.

But did you know that the Petrol station only receives 9% of the cost of petrol?

40% is fuel duty, 17% is VAT, 27% is the cost of petrol to the supplier, 6% is the cost of biofuel content and the rest is supply and delivery costs.

- (b) How many matches has he lost?

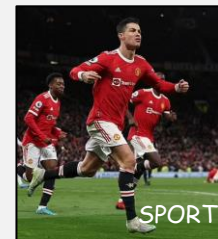
Roger Federer is the current tennis player with the most career wins. He has won five hundred and fifty one more matches than Andy Murray.

Blue lobster found by Jersey fisherman in 'one in two million' catch

A fisherman has shared photos of a rare bright blue lobster caught in the sea off Jersey.

The crustaceans are a bright blue due to a genetic abnormality that causes them to produce more of a certain protein than others of their species.

An expert from Oxford University's zoology department said the chance of catching a blue lobster is estimated at about one-in-two-million.
