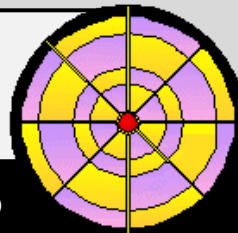

Spain holiday warning as Brits heading to Benidorm face extra costs

Brits heading to Benidorm could have to fork out more for a holiday thanks to a new tourist tax. The Valencian government is going to introduce a nightly charge from next year, adding to the cost of a Spanish holiday.

It is proposed that a tourist will have to pay €2 per night in tax to stay in a 4 or 5 star hotel.

VAR in Scottish football: Premiership clubs to pay for system on sliding scale

Scottish Premiership clubs will bear the cost of Video Assistant Referee technology on a sliding scale depending on their finishing positions.



All 42 Scottish Professional Football League clubs will vote on the proposal on Tuesday.

If approved, VAR will be used in Scottish domestic games for the first time after December's World Cup finals.

The 12 top flight clubs will each pay a percentage of the overall cost of the system depending on where they finish in the league.

The teams that finish in 11th and 12th positions will each pay the same percentage.
