She is being honoured for her work in medicine and in women's rights with her portrait by Francis Dodd appearing on the reverse side of the new polymer banknote.

The new note, which will replace the cotton version, has a number of updated security features and will retain novelist and poet Sir Walter Scott, alongside an image of The Mound in Edinburgh, on the front.
