Dunfermline to become Scotland's eighth city

About 40 locations applied for city status and were evaluated by a panel of experts and Cabinet Office ministers, before a recommendation was put to the Queen.

Dunfermline was successful in its bid alongside Bangor in Northern Ireland, Colchester, Doncaster and Milton Keynes

in England, Douglas in the Isle of Man, Stanley in the Falkland Islands and Wrexham in Wales.
