Argentina win the Qatar World Cup 2022

Lionel Messi finally achieved his World Cup dream as Argentina won their third crown on penalties in one of the greatest finals in the tournament's history.

Argentina won the shootout 4-2 against France after a spectacular game in which Messi scored twice and Kylian Mbappe scored a hattrick. It is no surprise that this was the highest scoring World Cup of all time!

Wales, Tunisia, Qatar, Denmark and Belgium were the lowest scorers in the tournament with 1 goal each. Mexico, Uruguay and Canada each scored one more goal than this.

Poland, Saudi Arabia, Costa Rica and the USA all scored 3 goals.

Australia, Ecuador, Cameroon and Iran all scored one more than the 4 teams above.

Senegal, Japan, Switzerland, Serbia, Ghana and South Korea all scored 5 goals each.

Germany and Morocco both scored 6 and Brazil and Croatia both scored 8 goals.

Spain scored 9, the Netherlands scored 10, Portugal scored 12 and England scored 13 goals.

Argentina scored 5 times the number of goals that Poland did.

France, the tournament top scorers, scored 4 times the number of goals scored by Iran.
