#### The New Year starts off with a Fibonacci date!

The year 2023 has started off with a mathematical bang - from a certain point of view! Todays date is in the form of a Fibonacci sequence when written in the form d/m/first digit of year/second digit of year.



A Fibonacci sequence follows the rule that each number is equal to the sum of the preceding two numbers.

Using the format above, todays date can be written as the sequence 1, 1, 2, 3, ...

Let's suppose the date could now be written in the form;

d/m/first digit of year/second digit of year/minutes/hours.

At what time of day would the date still be a Fibonacci sequence?
