Pasta price almost doubles as cost of basics rises

The price of pasta has nearly doubled in two years, new research suggests.

A standard 500g bag of pasta was 50p two years ago - now it costs 90% more.

Tommy Fury wins grudge match versus Jake Paul by split decision



Fury, 23, was the busier fighter, landing more accurate punches and demonstrating his boxing fundamentals.

Although the former Love Island star, brother of WBC heavyweight champion Tyson Fury, was knocked down by YouTuber-turned-boxer Paul in the eighth round.

The scoring was decided by three judges. Two of the judges gave point scores of 76-73 in favour of Fury. The third judge scored the boxing match in favour of Paul by a single point.
